## Salutation to your solution! - Answers 1

- **1.** Anand beat Vivek by 30 meters, which means in a given time Anand covered 1500 meters and Vivek covered 1470 meters. Anand beat Swaroop by 100 meters, which means Anand covered 1500 meters and Swaroop covered 1400 meters. It indicates that in 1470 meters distance Vivek ran 70 meters more than Swaroop. So in the next 30 meters Vivek covers  $(30 \times 70)/1470 = 2100 / 1470 = 10/7$  meters. So Vivek beat Swaroop by 500/7 meters = 71.42857 meters.
- 2. TETTFFSSE.

**Solution:** Pattern is O for One, T for Two, T for Three etc. So the next 9 letters are Ten (T), Eleven (E), Twelve (T), Thirteen (T), Forteen (F), Fifteen (F), Sixteen (S), Seventeen (S), Eighteen (E).
